Since mid-2008, the .au Domain Administration (auDA) has endorsed secondary market sales and monetisation for com.au and .net.au domains. This has created a dynamic and viable investment opportunity for domain professionals. Whilst still in its infancy, this emerging market is set to become one of the most lucrative ccTLDs for the following reasons:

- Untapped potential (only 1.5 million registrations)
- Quality names available (new registrations and drops)
- Low bid competition in the drop market
- Policy deregulation allowing the monetization and selling of .au's
- Online advertising continually growing (Q3 2009: totaling \$466M*)
- Online advertising exceeded \$1.8B for FY 08/09*
- Locally, .au is the most trusted extension

From June 1, 2008, auDA allowed .au domain names to be marketed and sold to eligible third parties. Whilst there are still a number of restrictions, the .au aftermarket has been a hive of activity, with at least 3 six-figure sales being reported.
